JOINT APPRENTICESHIP TRAINING COMMITTEE IBEW Local 625 TRAVEL POLICY



This policy applies to any courses taken for either the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee or for the Work Ready Safety Training Program. A travel allowance will be paid if the normal route travelled from a member's permanent regular place of residence is further than fifty (50) kilometers from the Electrical Workers Campus located at 24 Beechville Park Drive or any remote training facility used to deliver a course. The chart below shows the total allowance amount based on the distance travelled. It is based on the published Automobile allowance rates as per the Canada Revenue Agency, the rate for 2025 is \$0.72 per kilometer. Any member travelling further than one hundred (100) kilometers will receive a flat rate of \$135.00. Carpooling is encouraged, only the driver receives the travel allowance.
